Overnight Lock-In / NorCal ON FIRE Jam Code of Conduct and Consent

The following rules of conduct will help our event go smoothly and ensure the safety of all participants. Please take the time to review the list below with your parents, sign it, and return it to the Youth Ministry Office prior to the date of the event. Remember to also complete and return the permission slip.

1. Participation in all group activities is expected. Youth ministry is all about building relationships --so relax, get to know everyone, and have a good time!
2. Anyone arriving after 7:00am on Saturday, Sept. 22nd must have a parent notify the youth ministry office ahead of time. Once signed in, you will NOT be allowed to leave until the lock-in is officially over. If you will need to leave early, please have a parent submit a written approval including the time of release and method of transportation.
3. Once the lights are officially 'out' at bedtime, under no circumstances can the boys enter the girls'sleeping quarters and vice versa. Notify a chaperone or adult leader should the need arise or if there is a problem.
4. Stay together as a group. If you need to leave the group e.g. bathroom run, notify an adult leader or chaperone FIRST, then take a buddy with you. Never be alone.
5. Be respectful of your surroundings. Surroundings include people, property, animals, and motor vehicles. Remember that you are representing Resurrection Parish -- a Catholic community. When in doubt, "Treat others the way you want to be treated."
6. Public displays of affection (PDA) are not allowed. Only hugging and holding hands are considered appropriate.
7. No possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco. Violation of this rule will result in an immediate phone call to a parent to arrange a ride home.
8. No fighting, weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosives. Any items found during the event will be returned to a parent at the conclusion of the event.
9. No offensive or immodest clothing.
10. Minors under 18 years old are not allowed to drive any motor vehicle at any time during the event. Adults (21+) are only allowed to drive themselves or other adults.

I have read and understood this consent form and I agree to abide by the rules above. I also understand that failure to comply will result in a warning the first time, a conference with all the leaders/chaperones and possible separation from the group the second time, and a call to a parent to arrange a ride home immediately the third time.

Furthermore, I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to provide adequate emergency and health information to the RYM director and adult volunteers, as well as providing health insurance for my child.
